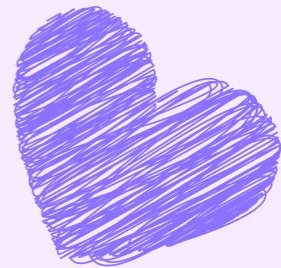

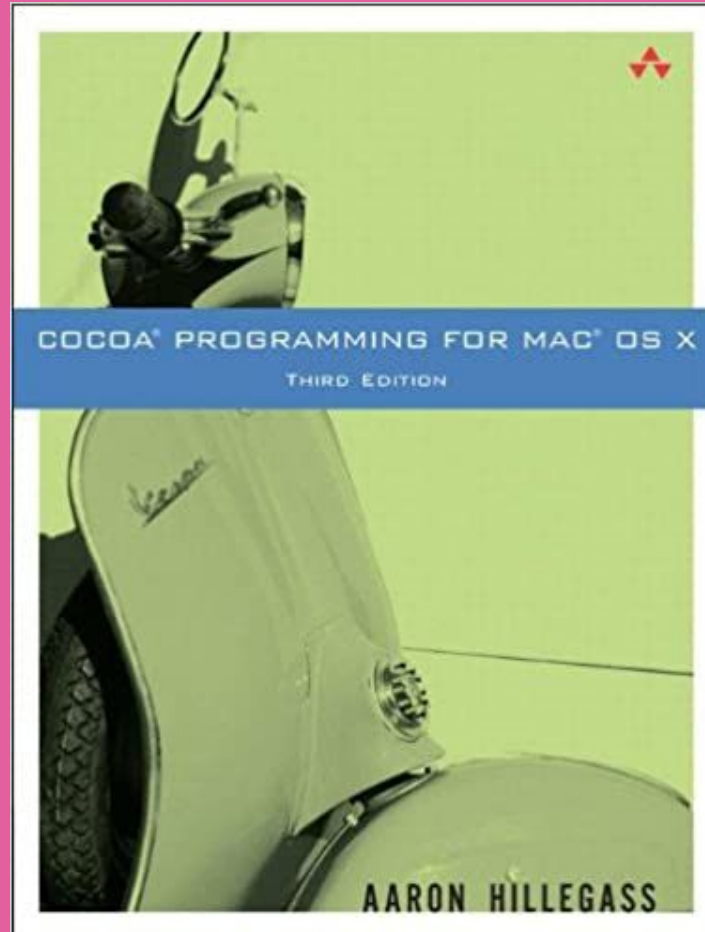

generalists

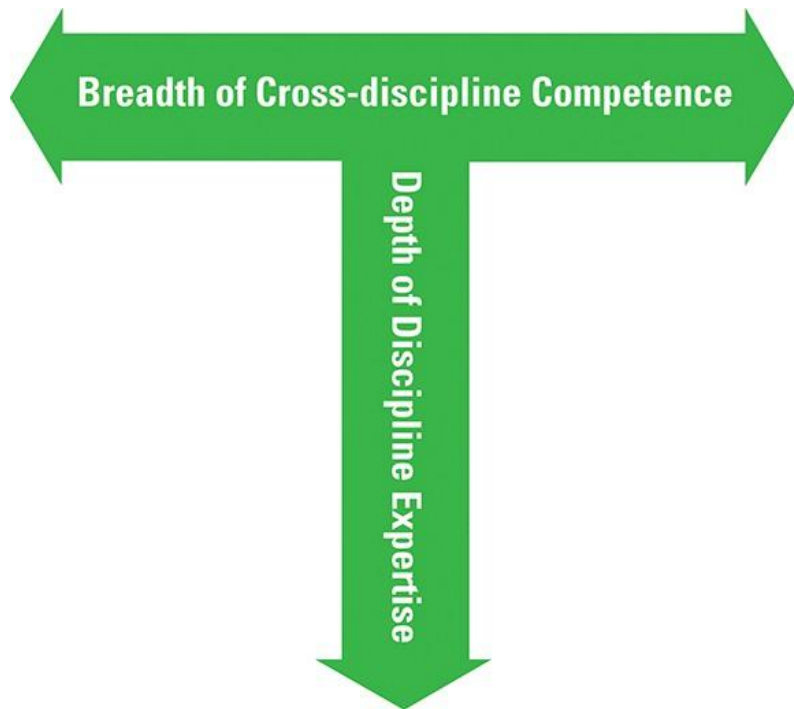
Generalists have a wide range of diverse skills.

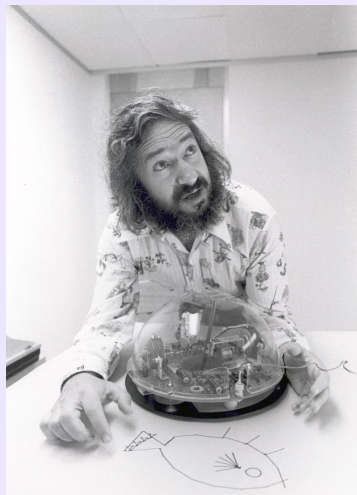

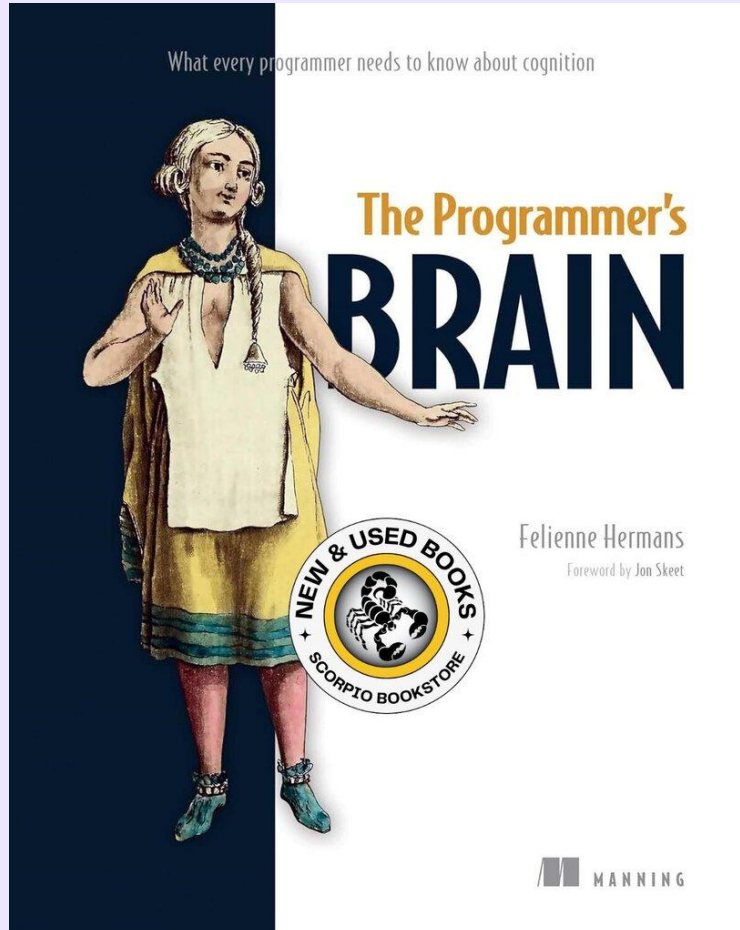

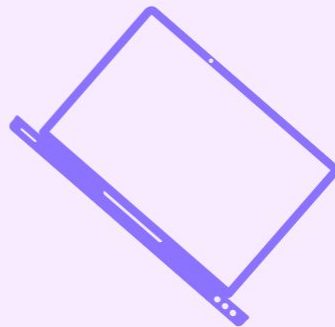
